BOROUGH OF MANASQUAN ORDINANCE NO. 2175-15

ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 2 (ADMINISTRATION) SECTION 2-65 (FEES CHARGED FOR MUNICIPAL SERVICES) AND AMENDING SUBSECTION 2-65.4 (APPLICATION FEE AND SECURITY DEPOSIT FOR USE OF MUNICIPAL BEACHFRONT FACILITIES) OF THE BOROUGH OF MANASQUAN CODE IN THE BOROUGH OF MANASQUAN, COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Revised General Ordinance of the Borough of Manasquan Code section 2-65 refers to Fees Charged For Municipal Services for various administrative services provided by the Borough of Manasquan; and

WHEREAS, the Manasquan Borough Council of the Borough of Manasquan is desirous of amending Subsection 2-65.4 entitled "Application Fee and Security Deposit for Use of Municipal Beachfront Facilities" in order to offset the cost to Manasquan for processing requests and providing municipal services; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Subsection 2-65.4(a) entitled "Application Fee and Security Deposit for Use of Municipal Beachfront Facilities" shall be amended to read:

- a. In order to offset the cost to Manasquan for processing requests and providing municipal services, it is required that any person or entity applying to utilize the beachfront facilities for a special event pay a nonrefundable application fee of one hundred fifty (\$150.00) dollars. Additionally, the person or entity shall deposit the sum of four hundred (\$400.00) dollars as a security deposit for costs incurred by Manasquan for services provided by the Police Department, Beach Department and Department of Public Works, and to cover the cost of damage sustained to municipal property. The security deposit, less any costs incurred by Manasquan, shall be returned to the person or entity holding the event within fifteen (15) business days following such activity. In the event the costs incurred by Manasquan and/or the costs of damage sustained to municipal property exceed four hundred (\$400.00) dollars, the person or entity holding the event shall be responsible for such excess costs. Manasquan, shall in its sole discretion, determine the costs incurred in accommodating a special event. Special events shall include: athletic events, fundraising events and similar activities. If the application is approved, the person or entity shall pay to Manasquan the fee of one hundred fifty (\$150.00) dollars per event for each day beyond day one of usage subject to time limitations imposed by the Borough of Manasquan.
- c. Any person receiving approval to hold a wedding or civil union at the beachfront shall pay a nonrefundable fee of one hundred fifty (\$150.00) dollars. No security deposit shall be required for this type of event.

Section 2: Construction and effective date

- (a) Should any section or provision of this ordinance be held invalid in any proceedings, the same shall not affect any other section or provisions of this ordinance, except insofar as the section or provisions so held invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder of any such section or provision.
- (b) Chapter 97, et seq., of the Borough of Manasquan Code and all ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance herewith are hereby repealed.
- (c) This ordinance shall become effective following its final passage and publication according to the law.
