

**BOROUGH OF MANASQUAN  
ORDINANCE 2185-15**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING  
CERTAIN FINES AND PENALTIES  
IN THE REVISED GENERAL  
ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH  
OF MANASQUAN, MONMOUTH  
COUNTY, NEW JERSEY**

**WHEREAS**, the Manasquan Borough Council of the Borough of Manasquan, County of Monmouth is desirous of amending and supplementing certain fines and penalties in the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Manasquan; and

**WHEREAS**, the Manasquan Borough Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the Borough to amend the following fines and penalties.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Manasquan, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1: The penalties in the sections and subsections of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Manasquan below are hereby amended.

<b>CHAPTER 3 POLICE REGULATIONS</b>		
<b>3-2 CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IN PRIVATE AND PUBLIC PLACES.</b>	3-2.1 Consumption in Certain Places.	Minimum \$450 fine
<b>3-19 DISORDERLY CONDUCT.</b>	3-19.6 Nudity, Indecent Exposure and Urinating in Public Prohibited.	Minimum \$450 fine and Maximum \$2,000 Fine
<b>3-28.3 NUISANCE PROHIBITIONS ENUMERATED</b>	3-28.3 Nuisances. Violation of any provision of subsection 3-28.3	Minimum \$450 fine and Maximum \$2,000 Fine

<b>Chapter 6 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL</b>		
<b>6-8 PERSONS UNDER THE LEGAL AGE.</b>	6-8.8 Violations and Penalties. a. The penalty is amended to comply with N.J.S.A. 33:1-81 with a minimum penalty of five hundred (\$500.00) dollars.	\$500 minimum fine

**Section 2:** Construction and effective date

- (a) Should any section or provision of this ordinance be held invalid in any proceedings, the same shall not affect any other section or provisions of this ordinance, except insofar as the section or provisions so held invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder of any such section or provision.
- (b) Chapter 97, et seq., of the Borough of Manasquan Code and all ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance herewith are hereby repealed.
- (c) This ordinance shall become effective following its final passage and publication according to the law.


